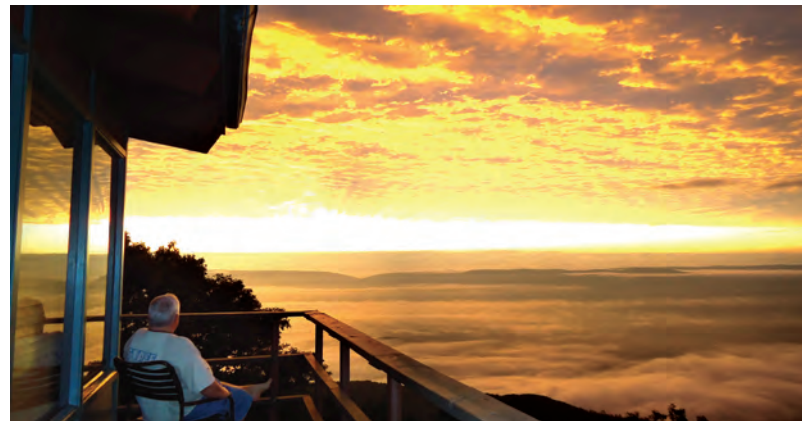

Instead of ministering in just one or two countries, look at all the things God is allowing CTW/LifeQwest to be involved in internationally! **We are now partnering in the USA, Central America, Europe, India, Africa, Asia and the Caribbean.**

Street Ministry Mission: Partnering with people who live on the streets to serve in their communities right where God has placed them. Working with groups to better serve our communities through sustainable projects.

Their story: Our family was living a lifestyle of always trying to upgrade our things; car, furniture, landscaping, etc. We found that we were spending 60 hours a week in an office, 30 hours a week maintaining (cleaning the pool and house, mowing, weeding, trimming, fixing up, re-arranging, decorating, and entertaining), blah, blah, blah. In November of 2009 we sold everything and moved into an RV, our ministry command post. This lifestyle change enables us to move and serve at His will.

As we listened to God's voice with our families call to service the name He gave us for the ministry was "Wear Gloves". We put on our gloves when the work is hard and as the Apostle put it in Matt. 9:37 "the harvest is plentiful and the workers are few."

Now, without the distractions of maintaining that suburban lifestyle we now find time to hit the streets and serve wherever needed. We work food pantries, clothing distribution, interfaith kitchens, International missions, child care facilities, nursing homes and with local groups to better serve their communities.

USA | SHOD (New Pastor Training) Jason Hatch

Jason states, "In January, 2009, God spoke to me very specifically about a special call on my life, in addition to my Pastor duties at my church. He told me to spend a considerable amount of my time and energy preparing young men for future ministry in local churches. I am the college pastor at First Baptist Irving, and we have a lot of ministerial students from DBU. There are a lot of young men attending DBU who are called to pastor. Sadly, I have seen many walk through the halls, graduate, and get jobs in ministry that were never actually prepared or qualified to defend and push forward Christ's gospel.

God called me to develop an intense, narrowly focused, and highly committed 10 month program to train young men to pastor. The two qualities that these men must have to be successful in this program have always been teach-ability and commitment.

Commitment, teachability, community, and an open Bible are a recipe for revival in the US. I knew that we needed a strong focus on 2 things;

- 1) Learning the details of the church and the duties of a pastor.**
- 2) Giving these men a chance to 'DO' these things after they read about them.**

That is the heartbeat of SHOD. Learning combined with "DOING." CTW/LifeQwest is coming alongside Jason with financial support for this incredible ministry! (Shown below)

USA | Children in Poverty Outreach Amy Watley

INDIA | Rehoboth Ministries Sastry Meesala & Rev. Kantharao Meesala

Pioneering Bible School: Reaching the unreached in our generation is the vision God has given to Rehoboth Ministries India. For this to become a reality, we realized that we would need to send out many more pioneer missionaries to begin church planting and discipleship ministry among all the unreached people groups of India. Our passion is to instill in each student the vision to take the Gospel to the unreached, provide on-the-job training through ongoing outreach ministry, give them quality training in the Word of God and prepare them for pioneer work, hardships, persecution and a life of faith through Jesus.

Church Planting & Discipleship: In India, there are many villages that have never heard the gospel of Jesus Christ for the first time. Our passion is to reach out to these remote villages and towns with the message of love and hope. Our aim is to plant churches in the most unreached areas by sending native missionaries. We act as a support network for these workers by helping to provide tools to evangelize, finances to get started and advocacy with the rest of the church. By empowering the workers, the church grows and spreads to new areas.

Orphan Home & School: In many places, orphaned and abandoned children are facing unbelievable abuse and exploitation. A large percentage of these children end up living a life of crime, prostitution and addictions. We help these children through rescue operations, housing, food, clothing and education. Most of the children are from non-Christian backgrounds. They find love and acceptance which many of them have never known in our center.



Community Development Projects: With the support of CTW/Lifeqwest, we are able to reach out to communities through water and feeding projects, neighborhood cleanup, partnership in community construction, sports and educational outreaches. These services show their neighbors that they are loved, valued, and accepted.

Native Missionaries: Sending native missionaries to plant churches is a natural and efficient way to reach India. About \$200 can meet all the needs of one missionary for a month.

Youth & Children's Ministry: Our vision is to encourage youth to realize their valuable role in God's ministry by organizing fellowship groups, seminars and one day retreats. One of the main goals of this ministry is to teach Christian moral and ethical values to the youth of India.

Mission Trips: We work with teams from churches in the US and India to reach the lost in India by teaching leaders, sharing the Gospel, bringing needed skills and talents.

SOUTH & CENTRAL AMERICA | Mission Adventures Drew Eubank

Drew is the Mission Adventures Program Coordinator. His organization coordinates and trains others in Central and South America to sponsor Christian Sports & Day Camps. Their mission site states, *"We're all about taking the road less traveled! It usually requires a backpack, sleeping in tents, packing in all supplies and living amongst the native people. It's a God-sized task and produces a God-sized change in the lives of people on both sides of the trip."*

We had the privilege of having Drew coordinate and bring a training team to Mongolia for our Sports Camp projects. CTW/LifeQwest is helping with these continuing projects through Drew's organization.

Romanian Pastor – Development Network and Seminary

Pastor Marian Paduret is a lead pastor and church planter in Bacau, Romania.
